2016-2017 ASPE Richmond Chapter Season

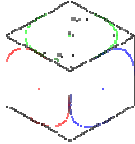

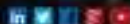

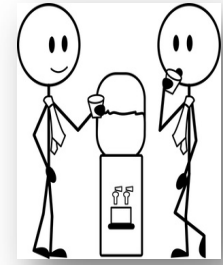
