 - d. Cast Iron Pipe, Hub and Spigot Gaskets: ASTM C564
- B. Cast Iron Soil Pipe Markings: All cast iron soil pipe shall be clearly marked with the manufacturer's name, country of origin, eight-digit date code, pipe diameter and length, relevant ASTM standard and registered trademark of the third party certifier. Third party certifier shall be IAPMO, ICC, NSF or other organization that is accredited as an ANSI Guide 65 organization. See www.ansi.org.
- C. Material Test Reports: Supplier of cast iron soil pipe and fittings shall be able to provide material test reports in accordance with the relevant ASTM standards and shall include testing and analysis on: radioactivity, dimensional characteristics, tensile strength and chemical/metallurgical content. Suppliers shall also provide MSDS on all coatings.
