2018-2019 ASPE Richmond Chapter Season

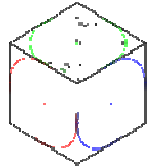

Membership Options

We are pleased to announce some new membership initiatives to help you make the most of your ASPE membership. Please see descriptions of these initiatives below, or for more information, contact the Membership Department at skidd@aspe.org.

Multiple-Year Membership Renewal

Now you can save on your ASPE membership dues if you join or renew for more than one year. Early Renewal Discount for First-Year Members

Eligibility guidelines for this discount follow:

- Only those who joined after July 1, 2018 are eligible.
- Only 125 members per quarter can take advantage of this offer.

Multiple Chapter Affiliation

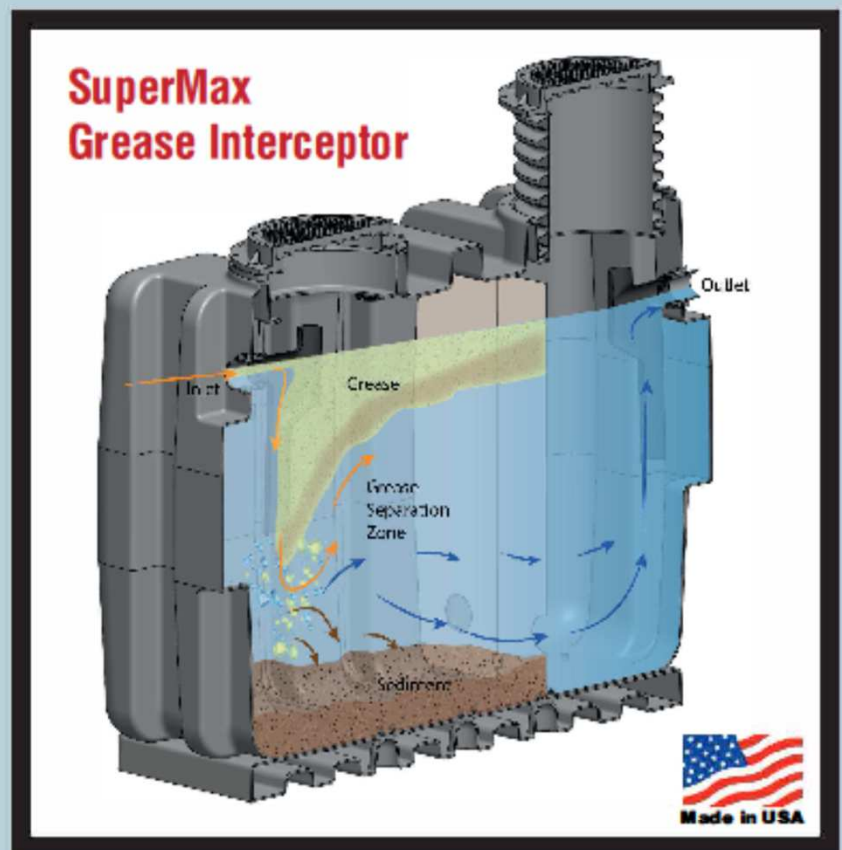

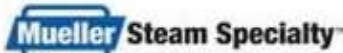

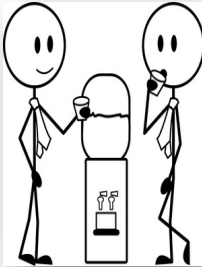
