Retrieve Your External CEUs on aspe.org

You've probably heard, but aspe.org is changing very soon! With that comes the retirement of our current CEU Center. All current and future continuing education programs and certificates now live on education.aspe.org and under My Education.

Before we bid the old CEU Center a farewell I strongly encourage you to login to aspe.org (not your Connect or Education login) and download any and all certificates you wish to have on file. The direct link is: aspe.org/CEUList

This link is only accessible to members who have logged in to aspe.org. You do not need to do this for Society-issued CEUs or certificates. Only third-party issuers.

The deadline to retrieve PDFs of certificates you earned from third party issuers, such as ASPE chapters or CEU providers, is November 1, 2019. After this date, you will not have access to PDFs and earned certificates on aspe.org. If you need these certificates to submit CPD or CPDT recertification, or varying licenses, you must retreive these before November 1, 2019.

Information regarding future CPD/T recertification will be shared with active CPDs and CPDTs in the coming weeks. If you have any questions please let me know.


